

We examined them for typical characters, settings and events and used this knowledge to create our own pirate stories and freeze frame them in our pirate area. In maths we have been exploring measures including weight, length, height and capacity. We began by using non-standard measures such as cubes and felt tip pens to measure ensuring they were the same. We then looked at cm and metres and then practiced using a ruler to measure. Once we had measured we found the difference between the length.
