### A MESSAGE FROM MISS CHOMA

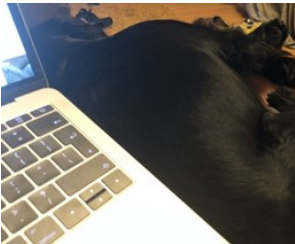

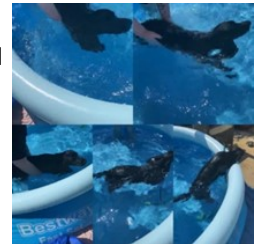

We thank you especially for the gift of music.

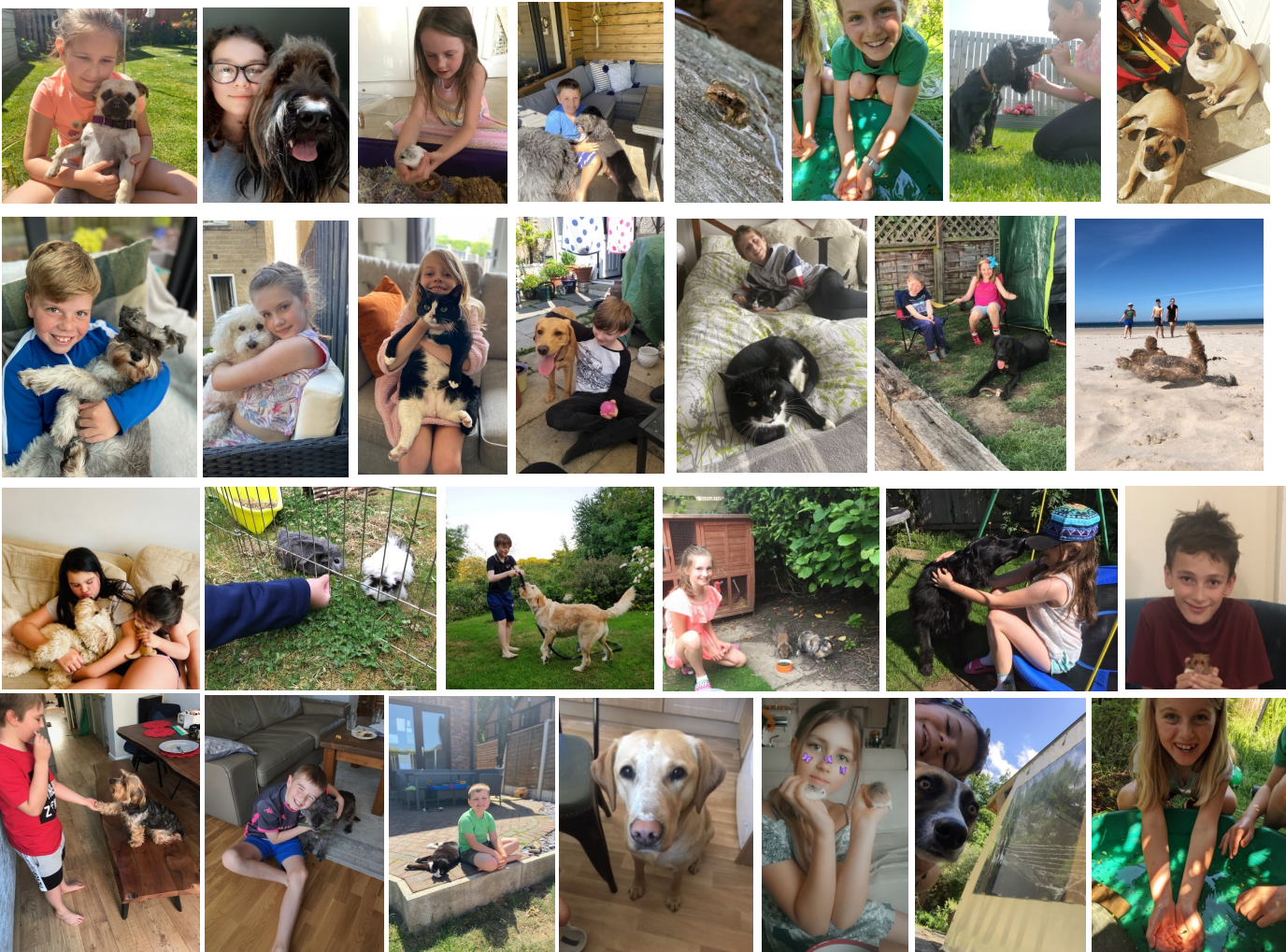
May we continue to enjoy music, using it to bring joy to our world.
