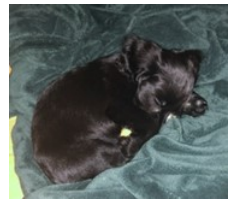
A MESSAGE FROM MISS CHOMA

And You shall renew the face of the earth. Amen



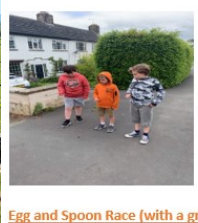
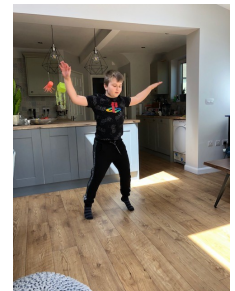
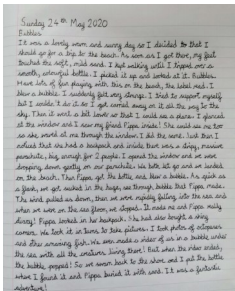
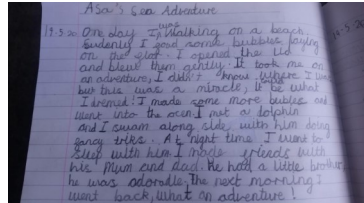
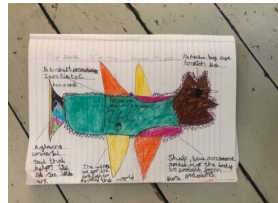
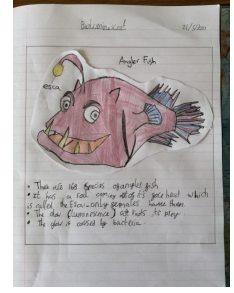
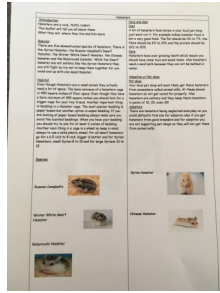
HOME LEARNING PHOTOGRAPHS
