## Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day) <br> Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Visit the White Rose Maths Home learning page. Year 3 Year 4
They have daily tasks which include a short tutorial video, followed by an activity to print and complete.
- Work on Times Table Rockstars
- Work on MyMaths and complete daily tasks.
- Play on Hit the Button - focus on number bonds, halves, doubles and times tables.
- Adding totals of the weekly shopping list This shopping game could support work on adding money.
- Practise telling the time. This could be done through this time game.
- Get a piece of paper and ask your child to show everything they know about Money. This could be pictures, diagrams, explanations, methods etc. They can be as creative as they want to be.
- Practise counting forwards and backwards from any given numbers in $4 s$.
- You could share a story together. This could be a chapter book where you read and discuss a chapter a day.
- Listen to your child read and let them discuss what they have read. Encourage them to read with expression and intonation.
- Watch Newsround and discuss what is happening in the wider world.
- Get your child to read a book on Active learn and complete the activities.
- With your child, look in magazines, newspapers and books for new vocabulary they are unfamiliar with. They could use a highlighter to highlight in magazines and newspapers.
- Choose a descriptive passage from a book you have read this week. Make a list of examples of vivid imagery - similes, metaphors, alliteration, powerful verbs, adjectives and adverbs etc.

- Practise the Year 3/4 for Common Exception words.
- Choose 5 Common Exception words. Write a synonym, antonyms, the meaning and an example of how to use the word in a sentence. Can the word be modified?
- Choose 5 Common Exception words
- and practise spelling them using a method of your choice from your spelling menu.
