

Learning Project WEEK 5 (Age Range: Y3/4) – Animals

Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Visit the White Rose Maths Home learning page. [Year 3](#) [Year 4](#)
- They have daily tasks which include a short tutorial video, followed by an activity to print and complete.
- Work on [Times Table Rockstars](#) - your child will have an individual login to access this.
- Create a times table grid like this one, filling in each answer ([times table grid](#)). Try make it colourful.
- Work on [MyMaths](#).
- Play on [Hit the Button](#) - focus on number bonds, halves, doubles and times tables.
- Working out change using money can be tricky. Practise using this [shopping game](#) - there are different levels of difficulty for you to choose.
- Practise telling the time. This could be done through this [time game](#)
- Get a piece of paper and ask your child to show everything they know about **Division**. This could be pictures, diagrams, explanations, methods etc. They can be as creative as they want to be.

Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- You could share a story together. This could be a chapter book where you read and discuss a chapter a day.
- Listen to your child read and let them discuss what they have read. Encourage them to read with expression and intonation.
- Watch [Newsround](#) and discuss what is happening in the wider world.
- Get your child to read a book on [Active learn](#) and complete the activities. These focus on comprehension skills.
- Explore new vocabulary you find when reading. What are the origins of this word? Can it be modified? Can you find any synonyms or antonyms for your new word?
- Pick a book you have recently completed. Think of 5 questions you would like to ask one of the characters. Then write their answers as if you were that character.

Weekly Spelling Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Practise the Year 3/4 for [Common Exception](#) words.
- Choose 5 Common Exception words. Write a synonym, antonyms, the meaning and an example of how to use the word in a sentence. Can the word be modified?
- Choose 5 Common Exception words and practise spelling them using a method of your choice from your spelling menu.

- Write a description of a fictional animal that has just been discovered. Think about what it looks like, where it lives and what it eats. Draw a picture to show what this new creature is like.
- Write a set of instructions for how to look after a pet. Remember to include what you need and what you do.
- Write a haiku poem about a bird of prey using information gathered.
(Think carefully about a haiku's structure, remembering the number of syllables required in each line)
