Writing Task

Listen to [Commotion in the Ocean](#) (or read it at home). Your task is to write a rhyming poem about a sea creature. You can choose one of the animals from the book or your own choice. Remember to try to think of words that rhyme first, and once you have some rhyming pairs of words, you can plan your poem. Once you have written it, read your poem out to make sure it rhymes!

Reading Tasks

Read at least 1 book a day on [Active Learn](#). Remember to find all the bugs in each book and answer them or the book won't be completed. Make sure you read the question before answering as I can see your answers!

Look around your house for any books that have sea creatures in them. Can you sort them into fiction and non-fiction books? How do you know?

Paul the Octopus was in the news in 2010 for being able to predict the future. Read '[Paul the Lucky Octopus](#)' and then answer this [quiz](#) about him.

SPaG Tasks

Task 1: Follow the [BBC Bitesize lesson](#) about using the word 'and' to join sentences. See if you can write about the ocean using and in every sentence. Remember not to use it too many times in the same sentence!

Task 2: Play [Buried Treasure](#) on Phonics Play and choose Phase 5 words. Try to decode all the words. If there is a sound you can't remember, write it down in a list. Then you can practice the sound on another day.

RE Task

The topic that we are focusing on in RE is the Resurrection.

Task 1: Show your child the story of the Ascension of Jesus on <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=UcFw8pLBSIo> or read the story in the Bible, Acts 1: 6-11. Discuss these questions with your child: How do they think the disciples felt? How did the disciples feel when they had to say goodbye? Your child could then have a go at creating an ascension craft like this:



Task 2: Ask your child to think about what they have learned about the Resurrection. Can they remember the story of Thomas? Is there anything they would like to learn more about? Can they explain what they have learned to someone else to teach them more about it?

Science Task

Animals

Task 1: Research some marine animals and try to group them into mammals, amphibians, reptiles, fish and birds. Can you find at least 2 animals that belong to each group?

Task 2: Using the animals you have found, group them into carnivores, omnivores and herbivores. Are there any patterns you notice? Can you tell whether an animal is a herbivore or carnivore by looking at its teeth or claws?
