# St Joseph's Catholic Primary School Curriculum Information Letter

## **ENGLISH**

We will be reading a wide variety of fiction and non-fiction texts. Children will use their knowledge and imagination to write stories, description and non-chronological reports These pieces of writing will support the children's learning of Year 2 grammar.

- Grammar lessons will include writing different types of sentences, nouns, noun phrases, adjectives, verbs and adverbs and conjunctions.
- Phonics and spelling lessons will take place daily. We will be completing phase 5d and moving onto spelling patterns in Phase 6.
- In guided reading, children will read, complete challenges and use IT to support learning.
- This term, we will continue to focus on developing our handwriting.

#### **HISTORY & GEOGRAPHY**

We will be investigating Continents and Oceans in Geography this term, following Izzi on her adventure across the world as she shares her knowledge about Continents and Oceans with us.

In History, we will be finding out about 'The Great Fire of London'. We will look at where the fire began and investigate how we know about the Great Fire and whether or not different sources are reliable.

#### **FRENCH**

We will be learning the names for colours in French.

## **MUSIC**

Children will be learning about the beat, rhythm and patterns in music through the use of playing percussion instruments.

# Spring 1 - The Good News

The children will learn that Jesus brought the good news of God's love and that this changed people's lives. They will learn that Jesus used his power to help others and reflect on the importance of these events.

They will reflect on how they can bring good news to their family and friends.

# Spring 2 - The Mass

Year 2 will learn and reflect on the importance of the celebration of the Mass. They will learn about the readings at Mass and why we should listen to them, and learn that at the Offertory we offer gifts to God. They will also appreciate that at the Consecration the bread and wine are changed into Jesus' Body and Blood.

## **PSHCE**

Our unit this term, is Similarities and differences.. This will include knowing that we are all unique and have our own special talents and skills.

#### PE

PE will take place on Tuesday and Friday. Children will be developing their balancing skills in Gymnastics. We will also be learning the basic skills of Badminton.

### ART & DT

We will be learning and developing our skills in: design, drawing, craft, painting and art appreciation; replicating the recognisable crockery of Clarice Cliff, exploring tone through shading, developing our skills in weaving and the manipulation of clay, experimenting with brush strokes.

Our DT work will link with our Science topic and we will be looking at designing and cooking a healthy snack.

## **MATHS**

Multiplication and division: Children will be:

- learning times tables.
- learning methods to add and subtract
- recognising and making equal groups of numbers

# Measurement: Children will be:

 recognising notes and coins, counting with notes and coins, and finding the difference between amounts.

## Statistics: Children will be:

- learning how to make tally charts
- draw pictograms
- interpret pictograms

#### **SCIENCE**

In our unit, 'Habitats', children will explore the adaptations animal have developed to survive in different environments.

In our unit 'Diet and Health', we will investigate what animals, including humans, need to survive. We will also look at eating a healthy balanced diet. We will then design and make a healthy snack.

### **ICT**

In Spring term 1, we will be learning about how to make music using IT.

In Spring term 2, we will be linking our work on Statistics and make pictograms using ICT.
