ENGLISH

Spring 1 - The Tear Thief by Carol Ann Duffy. Year 3 will...

- ✓ explore the imagery within The Tear Thief story.
- create a shared-poem, exploring different verb forms used in the text.
- ✓ write a letter in role using the present perfect form.
- compare a range of scenarios that may cause people to cry. The children explore the idea that tears are shed for different reasons.
- ✓ Create an information/ persuasive poster.

Spring 2 - Cinderella of the Nile

Year 3 will...

- write a news report based upon the story introduction.
- develop skills of inference and explore the author's use of literary language.
- ✓ write a diary entry in role.
- innovate their own story, based upon the story of 'Cinderella'.

SCIENCE: Animals including Humans

The children will learn about the importance of nutrition and are introduced to the main body parts associated with the skeleton and muscles. We work scientifically by: identifying and grouping animals with and without skeletons and observing and comparing their movement; exploring ideas about what would happen if humans did not have skeletons. They will ccompare the diets of different animals.

ICT - Animation

Year 3 will use a range of techniques to create a stop-frame animation using tablets. Next, they will apply those skills to create a story-based animation, adding other types of media to their animation, such as music and text.

Called to Change

The children will develop their understanding that Jesus called people to change, to turn away from sin and receive the love of God. They will learn that it is not always easy to change and find out about some individuals who changed through the help of Jesus. They will learn that the Sacrament of Reconciliation is a celebration of God's love and forgiveness and learn an Act of Sorrow.

Jesus the Teacher (Lent) The children will learn that Jesus was born into a Jewish family and find out about the story of the presentation in the Temple. They will learn that Jesus travelled about teaching people. The children will learn that Jesus came to show us the way to live, understand why Jesus used parables to teach people and know and understand some of the parables Jesus told. They will learn that Lent is a time to change in order to prepare for Faster.
