Use Minecraft to build a model of the Trojan horse or a temple like the Parthenon.

## Or

Use whatever material you like (such as lego or junk modelling) to make a Spartan shield or helmet; a statue of a god or mythical creature; a temple; or Jason's ship the Argo.

Write Make a travel brochure about Ancient Greece. Where would you travel to? Where would you stay? What could you do while you were there? Who would you recommend to visit? Use pictures with lots of facts and information.

Research the Greek myths behind the constellations.

Draw the constellation, tell the story as a comic strip.

Or

Find out about Greek Hoplite soldiers. How did they fight? What was their armour like? Why did they wear crested helmets?

**Design** and make an Ancient Greek vase and decorate it with scenes from mythology or daily life.

Alternatively, make models showing Doric, Ionic and Corinthian columns.

Or to make theatre masks for comedy/tragedy.

Olympics - PE

The ancient Olympic Games included running, long jump, shot put, javelin and boxing.

 You could create an Olympic games for you and your family.
 You could keep a log of how you do and how much you have improved. Create an A-Z of famous Greeks - they could be from myths such as Achilles or Echo, mythical creatures or real Greeks such as Plato.

Or write a fact sheet or poem about your favourite one.

Draw an Ancient Greek mythical creature (Cyclops, Centaur, Scylla..) or Greek God/Goddess or create your own. Write an information sheet about them or turn them into a set of posters.

Write a newspaper article about the feats of a Greek hero such as Theseus or Perseus (who slayed the Minotaur and Medusa), or about mortals punished by the Gods such as Arachne and King Midas. Write a diary extract from the viewpoint of a family member in Spartan or an Athenian. Try to write about your feelings about daily life and the things they do in your chosen city-state.

**Design** or **draw** your own Labyrinth. It could be made of straws, string or wood.



Watch and review films about Greek Mythology: Clash of the Titans, Jason and the Argonauts, Hercules, Percy Jackson, Horrible Histories. Draw a comic strip of the story or draw a poster advertising it

## Science

In Ancient Greece, boys did athletic activities like running, wrestling and throwing spears to keep fit, enter athletic competitions and prepare for life as a soldier.

- Why do you think it was important for boys and girls to be fit and healthy?
- How do the children in our class keep fit and healthy?
- Create a survey that would help us find out what type of exercise is most common in your friends and family? With the information, draw a bar model to show the information.
