USA GEOGRAPHY YEAR 6 PROJECT

For their home learning task, we would like the children to find out about the geography of the USA. For this they will need to answer the following questions:

- Where is the USA? (Include continent, bordering countries and oceans)
- What are the American states? How many are there?
- What and where are America's famous landmarks?
- Choose one landmark and write some information about it.
- What is the climate like in America? (This will vary across the USA)
- Name, and locate 10 significant American cities (you can choose which cities you think are significant.)
- Write a brief description for each city including: nickname, state, population, where it is, climate, sports teams and an interesting fact.

It is up to you how you present this information, you could make: a powerpoint, a leaflet, a poster, holiday brochure or use a variety of methods.

Additional activities

- Make a model of a famous American landmark.
- Find out about a period of American history.
- Research an American who inspires you.
- Find out about an American artist and try to create a piece of art in their style.
- Listen to some different music styles from the USA.
- Try to learn some dance steps that originated from America.
- Research the American flag or National Anthem.
