

St Joseph's Catholic Primary School Curriculum Information Newsletter



Literacy

The children will continue to have daily phonics sessions where they will be developing their skill of blending the sounds for reading and segmenting the sounds for spelling. The children will be learning new tricky words and digraphs. We will also focus on constructing sentences.

During our topic this half term, we shall be looking at a selection of fiction and non-fiction books based around our topic of Winter and the Polar Regions. We will be learning how to construct a sentence using a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop. We will also be practising our letter formation.

Expressive Arts and Design

As part of Expressive Arts, we will be making Arctic animals such as a penguins and polar bears.

This half term we will be studying the artist, Jackson Pollock. We will be creating our own masterpieces using a similar style.

We will continue our weekly music lessons with Mrs James. During these sessions, we will be focusing on pitch matchina.

Physical

PE takes place every Monday. Please ensure your child comes to school in a named PE kit on this day. This half term we will be learning about Throwing and Catching.

We will also continue to develop our gross motor skills through lots of opportunities to play outside.

RE

Our topic this half term is 'Getting to know Jesus'. We will learn that Jesus loves every one of us and think about ways we can show our love for Jesus. We will then hear how Jesus cured people who were ill & think of ways in which we can show our love for people who are ill. We will also learn about how Jesus showed that he was the Son of God at the Wedding at Cana and think about what this means for us.

Later on in the term, we will begin to learn about why we celebrate Easter.
